## **BALTIC SEA VISITED ISLANDS/SPITS (55+30 COMING)**

The criteria for an island is that it is inhabited or has a special character (f.ex. a lighthouse islet) and it is accessible by car over a bridge or a causeway and can be reached by a public or other scheluded boat. There are also three sand based spits on the list.

## **FINLAND (39+23)**

HAILUOTO FINLAND 1965/2021

The northernmost island of the Baltic Sea and third-largest island in Finland in the Botnic Bay.

HELSINKI CITY ISLANDS (10) FINLAND 1958, 1961, 1969-75, 2017, 2023

KORKEASAARI (1958), KATAJANOKKA ISLAND (1961), LAUTTASAARI (1969), SEURASAARI (1970), KULOSAARI (1970), KUUSISAARI (1970), LEHTISAARI (1970), LAAJASALO (1977), JÄTKÄSAARI (2016) are the largest city islands of the City of Helsinki, the Capital of Finland accessible by a bridge. VIAPORI or SUOMENLINNA (1969), is an inhabited historical fortress island just outside the city centre of Helsinki and reached only by a ferry in the Gulf of Finland.

HELSINKI ARCHIPELAGO (1+2) FINLAND 2017/2023

ISOSAARI (2017), KAUNISSAARI (2023) and VALLISAARI (2023) are the most important outer public islands accessible by a public boat.

ÅLAND ARCHIPELAGO (4+6) FINLAND 1987, 1993, 2009, 2023

Ahvenanmanner or FASTA ÅLAND (1987) is the main island of the autonomous region in the Swedish speaking Aland archipelago with the capital town of Mariehamn. There are eight other municipal islands in the Åland archipelago. FÖGLÖ (1993) by ferry from Mariehamn and ECKERÖ (1993) by bridge. There are ferry connections from Kustavi in the main land of Finland to the municipal islands of BRANDÖ (2023) and further to VÅRDÖ (2023) and KUMLINGE (2023) and to the Fasta Åland. From there by ferry to the municipal island of SOTTUNGA (2023) and back to Fasta Åland there over the bridges to the municipality islands of LEMLAND (2023) and LUMPARLAND (2023). MARKET REEF (2009) is the westernmost small island of Finland and it is divided between Finland and Sweden. To this lighthouse island there is a small motorboat access from the Åland island of Eckerö.

KASKINEN (1) FINLAND 1988

It is the smallest island town in Finland located by the western coast of Finland in the Botnic Bay.

VYBORG ISLANDS (2) FINLAND/RUSSIA 2009

A special boat visit from the Russian Vyborg to the island of MALAY VYSOTKI (RAVANSAARI was leased to Finland from Russia until 2014) via S-ISLAND of Russian Vyborg bay.

TURKU ARCHIPELAGO (9+5) FINLAND 2012-2016, 2023

It is, the biggest archipelago in the world by the number of islands of 50,000 in the Turku Archipelago Sea. It consists of the capital island PARAINEN a town surrounded by sea with four former municipality islands on the Archipelago Ring Road: NAUVO, KORPPOO, HOUTSKARI with MOSSALA and INIÖ plus the islands of NORRSKATA and JURMO. BJÖRKHOLMEN (2020), near Parainen and accessioble by a car ferry. LUONNONMAA, OTAVA,

LIVONSAARI, VELKUA and VELKUANMAA are the islands, which belong to the city of Naantali.

UTÖ (1) FINLAND 2016

It is a remote island in the Archipelago Sea and belongs to Pargas municipality. It is the southernmost year-round inhabited island in Finland. It has a famous lighthouse.

KÖKAR (1) FINLAND 2016

This very remote island is located in the Åland archipelago and accessed by a ferry from Korppoo island of Parainen.

KVARKEN ARCHIPELAGO (2) FINLAND 2021

RAIPPALUOTO is the forth largest island in Finland and BJÖKÖ is the westermost Finnish island by car both located in Merrenkurkku (Kvarken) in the Botnic Bay between Vaasa in Finland and Umeå in Sweden. It has UNESCO Heritage Site.

KIMITOÖ (1) FINLAND 2021

Kemiönsaari is an island and municipality in the southwestern archipelago. It is the second largest island in Finland.

BENGTSKÄR (1) FINLAND 2021

It is an island 25 kilometres southwest of Hanko, and part of the municipality of Dragsfjärd. This rocky island can be reached by ferry from the village of Kasnäs. Bengtskär Lighthouse on the skerry is the highest one in the Nordic countries.

PORVOO ARCHIPELAGO (2) FINLAND 2022

An around year inhabited group of islands with mainly Swedish speaking inhabitants and accessed by a ferry. PELLINKI is the largest and EMÄSALO second largest island and they both belong to the city of Porvoo and are located in the Porvoo archipelago in the Gulf of Finland.

KOTKA ARCHIPELAGO (4) FINLAND 1975 and 2022

Kotka city islands: KOTKA-ISLAND (1975), LUOTSI-KUUSINEN and MUSSALO (2022) belong to the city of Kotka and KAUNISSAARI (2022) is a popular summer island in the outer island of the Pyhtää municipality accessed by a ferry from Kuusinen harbour. It belongs to the wider Kotka archipelago in the Gulf of Finland.

TAMMISAARI ARCHIPELAGO (1) FINLAND 2023

JUSSARÖ (2023) is the outmost island in the Tammisaari national archipelago park in the Gulf of Finland.

UUSIKAUPUNKI ARCHIPELAGO (5) FINLAND 2023

**VOHDENSAARI, VYÖKKI, KAMMELA** and **HEINÄINEN** are the islands of the Velhovesi Ringroad and **ISOKARI** is a remote lighthouse island with a public boat.

RAUMA ARCHIPELAGO (2) FINLAND 2023

KYLMÄPIHLAJA (2023) light house island and KUUSKAJASKARI (2023) fortress island are the main islands with accommodation in the Rauma archipelago in the Botnic Bay.

MERI-PORI ARCHIPELAGO (3) FINLAND 2023

REPOSAARI (2023), KOOSHAAKA (2023) and ANTTOORA (2023) belong to the neighbourhood of Meri-Pori of the city of Pori in the Botnic Bay.

**SWEDEN (2+3)** 

GOTLAND SWEDEN 1984

The largest island of the Baltic Sea.

ÖLAND SWEDEN 2022

It is the second-largest Swedish island. It is located in the Baltic Sea just off the coast of Småland. It is separated from the mainland by the Kalmar Strait and connected to it by the 6 km long Öland Bridge.

STOCKHOLM ARCHIPELAGO SWEDEN 2023

**WAXHOLM** is the first stopover on the boat trip to **SANDHAMN**, which is the largest and most remote larger island of the archipelago.

VEN SWEDEN 2023

A small island in the Øresund strait.

**DENMARK (7+1)** 

ZEALAND DENMARK 1960

The Sjælland is the main island od Denmark with the capital of Copenhagen in Kattegat of the Danish Straits.

FUNEN DENMARK 1960

In the Danish Straits.

JUTLAND PENINSULA/ISLAND DENMARK 1960 GERMANY 1992

Jutland Peninsula is devided by Denmark and Germany and the Kiel Canal (Nord-Ostsee-Kanal) 1992 goes through German part from the North Sea to the Baltic Sea and actually makes it an island.

NORTH JUTLANDIC ISLAND DENMARK 1960
